

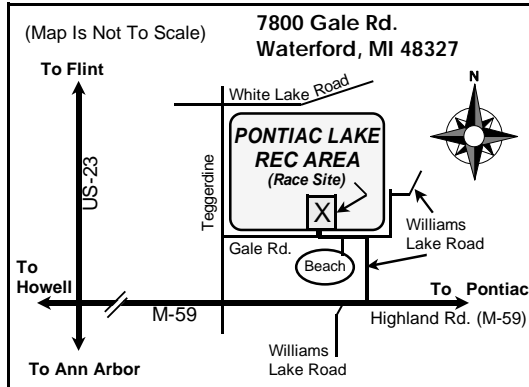
PONTIAC LAKE, WATERFORD, MI
